

FIRST, There are FOUR test subject areas on the GED test:

- ⇒ Math,
- ⇒ Social Studies
- ⇒ Science
- ⇒ Language Arts

A passing score on any GED test is 145.

Here is what YOU MUST HAVE BEFORE you can GED test:

- ☐ A valid state ID or driver's license.
- ☐ An email address. You must know your login and password. *If you don't have one, we will help!*
- ☐ IF you are under 18, you will need a state age waiver. *We will help you with this.*

Here is what the Family Literacy Center will do for you:

- ☐ Provide you with a tutor in any of the subject areas, as needed.
- ☐ Provide free Practice GED tests so we know when you are ready for the real test.
- ☐ Provide a place to work and study and lots of support and encouragement. We can help!
- ☐ Submit the age waiver to GED for you (if needed).

Here are the Steps to get your GED (we will help you!):

- ☐ **Intake testing.** You will complete a CASAS test. *It tells us what you need to work on and when you are ready to GED practice test. We will complete some intake forms and request your SS#.*
- ☐ **GED set up.** *You have to get an account with GED.com. We will help you.*
- ☐ **GED ready (practice) testing.** *When your tests and progress show that you are ready for any of the four test subjects, we will give you a practice test. It will tell us if you are likely to pass the real test and what you still need to study. We will pay for the practice tests when you are ready to test.*
- ☐ **Get a voucher.** *When you get "likely to pass" on the practice test, we will help you submit for a voucher from the state that will pay for that test.*
- ☐ **Scheduling a test with GED.** *If your practice test score indicates you are likely to pass a test, we will help you schedule your test at a testing center or remotely. If remotely, you can take one test at a time. You can take more than one at a testing center.*
- ☐ **Watching the video on GED.** *If you want to remote test, you must watch the GED instructional video. We will help you with this. You can remote test at our office.*
